About Ljubljana and hotel accommodation:

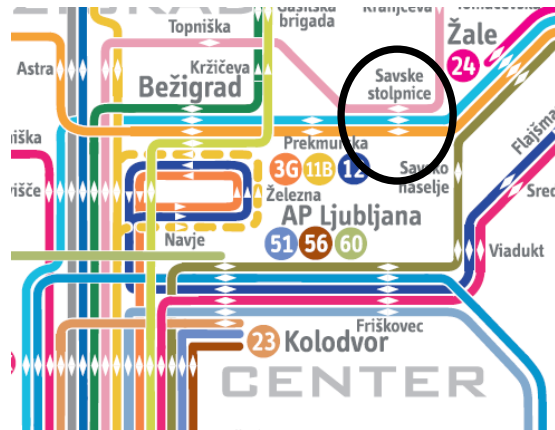
